FACTS ON PLASTIC

- ⇒ 160,000 plastic bags are used globally. 5 trillion plastic bags are produced yearly. Side by side that can encircle the world 7 times!
- ⇒ The Great Pacific Garbage Patch, which is a floating landfill of garbage in the Pacific is twice the size of Texas! It is mostly composed of plastic.
- ⇒ 12.7 million tons of plastic are dumped into the ocean every single year!
- ⇒ 50% of plastic we use, we only use once and throw it away.
- ⇒ The Average American throws away approx. 185 pounds of plastic every year.
- ⇒ 100,000 marine mammals and 1,000,000 sea birds are killed every year from plastic in the ocean.
- ⇒ 44% of all seabird species, 22% of cetaceans, all sea turtle species and a growing list of fish species have been documented with plastic in or around their bodies.
- ⇒ Virtually every piece of plastic that was ever made still exists in some shape or form.
- \Rightarrow It takes 500-1,000 years for plastic to degrade.
- ⇒ Plastic chemicals can be absorbed by the body. 93% of Americans age six or older test positive for BPA (a plastic chemical)
- ⇒ Americans throw away 35 billion plastic water bottles every year.

RISE ABOVE PLASTIC

- ⇒ Choose to reuse when it comes to shopping bags and bottled water. Cloth bags and metal or glass reusable bottles are available locally or on Amazon.com
- ⇒ Refuse single-use plastics such as: straws, bags and utensils.
- ⇒ Purchase reusable straws, bags and utensils online.
- ⇒ If you must use plastic, please recycle. When recycling properly, items must be rinsed and cleaned before putting into the bin.
- ⇒ Volunteer for beach and lake cleanups. Surfrider Foundation is an excellent place to start looking at where you can help!
